# Small Grants Programme for Individual Residents Policy

Date of Adoption: July 2004 Effective Date: July 2004

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### 1 Purpose

This policy provides guidelines to the distribution of the City of Canada Bay Council Small Grants Program for Individuals. This is an annual program.

A notice will be placed in the Bayside Brief and the Village Voice three times per year advertising the availability of 'Individual Grants' for eligible residents.

### 2 Amounts

The program currently allocates up to:

- 1. \$250 for local or regional event representation
- 2. \$350 for interstate event participation
- 3. \$500 international / overseas participation

Council will decide on an annual basis the total amount of funds available each year for distribution

### 3 Categories

Applicants must meet one of the following categories:

- · Sports competitor
- Cultural / arts achievement
- Academic / literary achievement

The activity shall be of amateur status.

### 4 Conditions

Applications must be received by Council at least *four weeks prior to the participant activity*. Grants will not be allocated in retrospect.

- · Applicants must be residents of Canada Bay
- There are no age specifications, however, if the applicant is under 18yrs of age, a letter of consent must be provided by a parent or legal guardian
- Applicants can receive only one donation per year from this program
- The funds are to be used only for the purposes detailed in the application approved by council
- The applicant, if granted financial assistance, is to be available to attend the official Council cheque presentation function
- Successful applicants must report back to council within six months of the event

### 5 How to apply

- An application form must be completed for consideration of an individual grant. Forms are available at Council offices or on councils website <a href="www.canadabay.nsw.gov.au">www.canadabay.nsw.gov.au</a>
  All applicants will receive a letter indicating the outcome of their request.

### 6 Cheque Presentation

The Mayor will present cheques, on behalf of Council, at a Council Meeting in March/April, August/September and November/December to those applicants who have been successful.
