Situated on the water at the end of Cabarita Road, Cabarita Park is a large open space area covered with trees. The park is the most popular location within Canada Bay for weddings and ceremonies due to its beautiful surroundings. Along with BBQ's and undercover areas with toilets and picnic tables around the park the Cabarita swimming pool and wharf makes it a top location for a day out.

Social Recreation groups can apply for temporary structures within the park as per terms and conditions.

Ceremonies and Wedding Photography are permitted at the park and can be booked for these occasions.
