

WEDDINGS IN COUNCIL PARKS

Canada Bay provides a number of picturesque settings to hold a wedding ceremony or to take wedding photographs.

There are a number of parks to choose from, including favourite locations such as:

- Cabarita Park, Cabarita
- Prince Edward Park, Cabarita

To make a booking, please complete the 'Ceremonies and related photography' application form, which can be found on the 'forms and fact sheets' page of our website or by contacting Council on 9911 6555.

Once your form is received with full payment, a confirmation will be sent to you. The same booking procedures apply for commitment ceremonies and naming ceremonies etc. at all Canada Bay Council parks.

Decorations may be brought into Council parks providing they are removed at the end of the ceremony and are not erected to any Council property. Council does not allow receptions, but a single table and minimal chairs may be set up for less mobile guests and bridal parties.
