

RIDER BOULEVARD PARKING ALTERATIONS TO IMPROVE PARKING AVAILABILITY

City of Canada Bay Parking Strategy

Background

In late 2010 Council notified the local community that pay parking was being considered. A review identified that Rider Boulevard, Rhodes, between Oulton Avenue and Shoreline Drive, was subject to parking congestion, with high demand and low turnover.

The planned parking strategy is aimed to:

- provide equitable access through increased parking turnover
- ensure some short-term parking is available.

Current position

Council approved and installed parking meters in Rider Boulevard between Oulton Avenue and Shoreline Drive. The Pay & Display parking meters, with credit card or coin payment facilities, were installed in February 2012.

What will parking fees be used for?

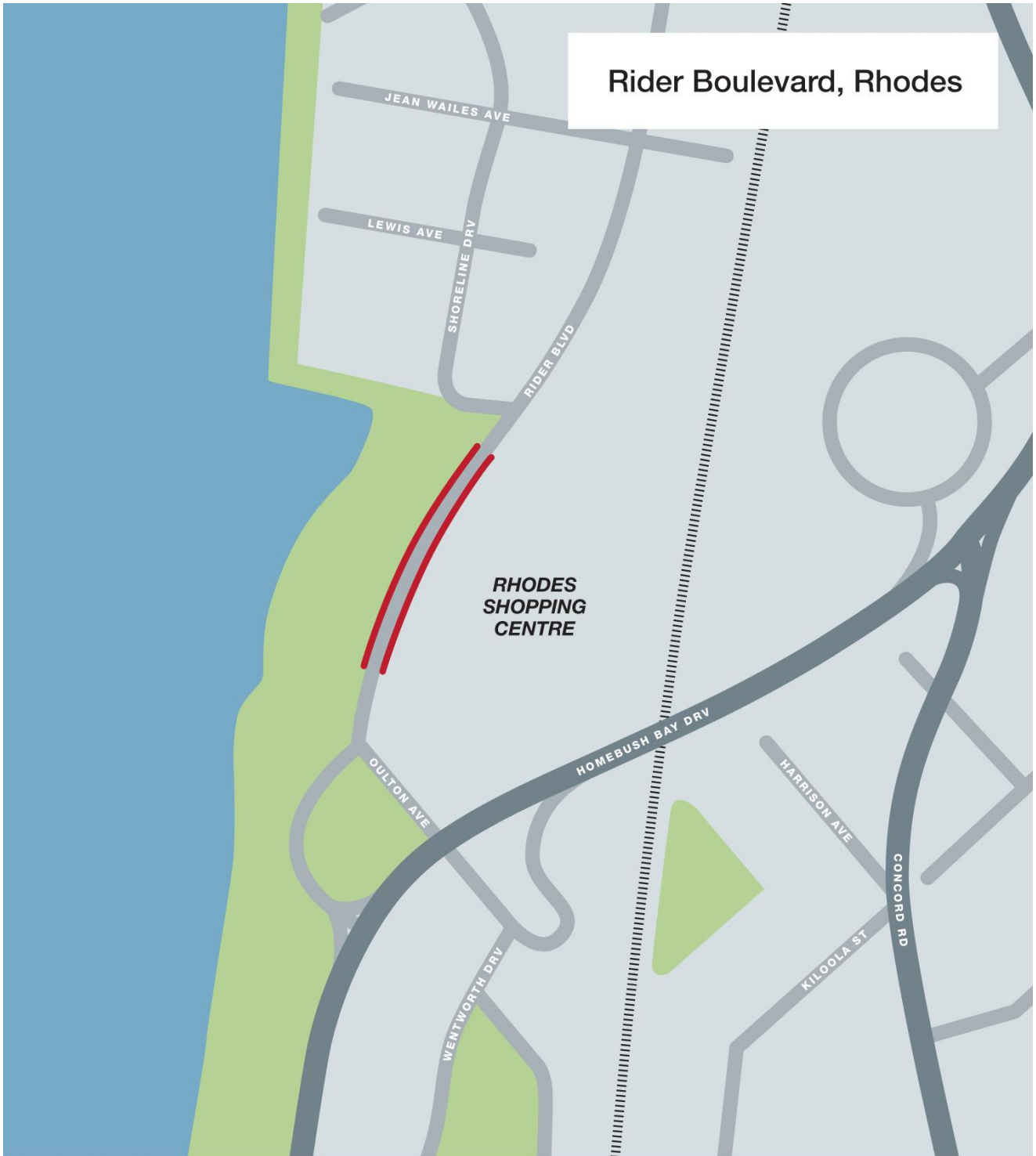
Council will use income received to fund additional public infrastructure work in the area, such as roads, lighting and footpath improvements.
