

YOUTH OUTREACH

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

We want to make sure that everyone feels welcome and safe in this space. It is expected that youth attending sessions demonstrate good behaviour and treat each other with respect and courtesy.

Youth participating in City of Canada Bay Libraries Youth Outreach programs are to:

- Respect other people's rights, worth and dignity
- Respect other's property, opinions and personal space and be responsible for their own property while in the space
- Behave in a respectful manner and not disrupt or cause potential harm to others in the space
- Assist in keeping the space clean and tidy and ensure that pathways are clear of any trip hazards
- Realise that bringing or accessing offensive material in the youth outreach program is not acceptable
- Understand that smoking or being under the influence of drugs and alcohol while in the space will not be tolerated
- Respect others using the library by keeping noise to a minimum
- Talk to Library staff if you are experiencing problems.

Please understand that any unsocial behaviour and/or failing to adhere to these rules will result in a series of warnings followed by temporarily being banned from participating in the youth outreach program.
